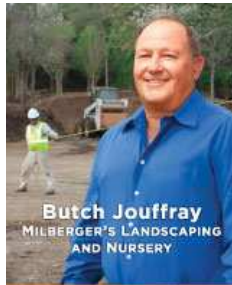

Not everyone is thrilled with the Senate budget

While there are those that like the Senate budget plan because it doesn't cut as deep there are those that like the House plan because it only spends the money the state has to spend and doesn't dip into the rainy day fund. One of those people is the Texas Public Policy Foundation's Talmage Heflin. He says the Senate needs to "cut back, get more realistic and stay within available revenue." He says this can be fixed in conference committee. "Hopefully the House will stand firm, although indications from Chairman Pitts are he'll be looking for more money, but we hope that he'll defend the House product that went to conference." He says if the state tries to sell property of use accounting tricks to make ends meet that will just put off part of the problem until next session, just as lawmakers did last session when they spend a lot of one time federal stimulus money.
