The Honorable Ted Cruz is the former Texas Solicitor General, who was the first Hispanic to serve in this position and the youngest solicitor general in the country at the time of his appointment. Cruz has authored more than 80 U.S. Supreme Court briefs and presented 37 oral arguments, including eight before the U.S. Supreme Court. Ted is one of Texas' rising stars sure to lead not only our state, but our country, back to the principles of our Founding Fathers as a Senior Fellow under our Center for Tenth Amendment Studies.

The Honorable Kathleen Hartnett White, director of our Armstrong Center for Energy and the Environment, is the former chairman of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, which is the largest environmental agency in the nation other than the EPA. Kathleen continues to regularly guide current commissioners on TCEQ rules while taking on the EPA's overreach into state matters. She is the foremost expert on energy issues in the state and one of the top in the country.
