



Facts about Incentive Pay

April 17, 2007

- Nearly **\$100 million** in incentive pay grants have already been awarded to more than **1,100 campuses** for the *current* school year.
- In addition, **1,132 campuses** have already been identified to receive **\$100 million** in grants in the 2007-08 school year. In total, more than **\$580 million** will be awarded over the biennium.
- Below is a small sample of the districts that have already been awarded incentive pay—and whose excellent teachers will receive a **pay cut** if the incentive pay program is repealed:
