
TEXAS TITLE INSURANCE

Is price-fixing a better alternative than competition? Texas' experience with title insurance says, "No!" Based on an apples-to-apples comparison, Texas has the fifth highest title insurance prices in the country.





A 2011 policy report by the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs put the blame for higher prices on the Insurance Code, noting that "the more comprehensive the degree of regulation, the higher the insurance rates." Texas remains one of only three states to artificially set and inflate title insurance prices. Consumers deserve better.
