Dear Counsels:

After careful review and deliberation of the briefs, memorandums, motions and argument of counsels, the Court has made the following findings and will issue the following orders: Plaintiffs' Application for Temporary Injunction is GRANTED. The Court, further, ORDERS that the amount of bond set by the Court be in the amount of \$37,500.00. The Court ORDERS that a date certain for a trial on the merits be set as soon as possible, as agreed by the parties and approved by the Court in the 225<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court.

I will request that the prevailing party of the respective Application draft an order reflecting the Order of the Court and submit it to opposing counsels for approval as to form only. I will sign the Order when submitted to the Court for signature. Further, I will instruct the clerk of the court to file all original papers, motions, briefs and memorandums with the District Clerk's Office. All exhibits will be returned to the official court reporter for further disposition. The Court will withdraw all exhibits upon the agreement of all the parties. Additional materials provided to the court will be given to the court reporter for safekeeping and retrieval by the respective parties. SO ORDERED.
