
Steven Mosher



Steven Mosher, an internationally recognized authority on China and world population, was the first American social scientist allowed to carry out research in the People's Republic since 1949. His year in China (1979-80) resulted in his landmark study of social life in China, Broken Earth: The Rural Chinese. The human rights abuses he uncovered in the one-child policy led to his firing from Stanford as the university sought to placate and angry China. He has served as a Commissioner of the Commission on Broadcasting to China, and has testified numerous times before Congress as an expert in world population and human rights. He has appeared on Tucker Carlson, Laura Ingrahm, Steve Bannon, the New York Post, Wall Street Journal, Science Times, 60 Minutes, and is a regular on radio shows aired around the world. Steven is also the author of a number of bestselling books on China including A Mother's Ordeal: One Woman's Fight Against China's One-Child Policy and Bully of Asia: Why 'China's Dream' is the New Threat to World Order.
