1 Should all voters who cast their ballot in-person be required to show a photo ID before voting?*

82%	Yes
11%	No
7%	Not sure

2 When someone mails in their ballot, should they be required to include their social security number or driver's license number instead of just a signature to verify their identity?*

67%	Yes
22%	No
11%	Not sure

3 The "For the People Act" would, in fact, prohibit states from requiring photo ID before voting. Knowing this, do you favor or oppose the "For the People Act?"*

22%	Strongly favor
18%	Somewhat favor
13%	Somewhat oppose
38%	Strongly oppose
9%	Not sure

4 Democrat state legislators have continued to publicly raise funds for their campaigns while they are in DC preventing any voting on any legislation. Do you approve or disapprove of state legislators fundraising while they block the ability of the state legislature to vote?*

18%	Strongly approve
19%	Somewhat approve
13%	Somewhat disapprove
38%	Strongly disapprove
11%	Not sure

Methodology

The survey of 1,000 Registered Voters in Texas was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. using a mixed mode approach from July 20-23, 2021. Most respondents were contacted online or via text while 93 were contacted using automated phone polling techniques. Online respondents were selected from a list of Registered Voters and through a process of Random Digital Engagement. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the state's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.
