

Bio for Justin Folk

Justin Folk is a film producer and director whose work explores culture, politics, and current events. After beginning his career in Hollywood on films including *The Matrix Reloaded*, *The Matrix Revolutions*, and *The Incredible Hulk*, he turned his focus to documentaries that examine some of the most consequential issues shaping society.

In 2019, Justin produced and directed the free-speech film *No Safe Spaces*, starring Dennis Prager and Adam Carolla, launching a series of documentaries that have resulted in widespread cultural impact. He followed with *What Is a Woman?*, starring Matt Walsh, which is one of the most-watched documentaries of all time and has been credited with influencing legislation around the country to protect women's spaces and outlaw harmful hormone therapy and gender mutilation surgery for minors. He reunited with Walsh to produce the comedic documentary, *Am I Racist?*, which added hundreds of thousands of subscribers to the *Daily Wire* and earned more than \$12 million in theaters, easily making it the highest-grossing documentary of the year.

His latest film, *Paging Hezbollah*, tells the inside story of Israel's 2024 exploding pager operation targeting the terrorist group Hezbollah. The documentary will be released in theaters and on home entertainment platforms this fall.
